ANNUAL REPORT

The Managing Committee takes pleasure in presenting the Nineteenth Annual Report and the Audited Statement of Accounts for the year ended 31.12.1989 before the General Body of Margi.

Annual General Body Meeting 1988

The Annual General Body meeting for the year 1988 was held on 30.3.1989 at the Margi Kathakali Vidhyalaya, Fort, Trivandrum.

Meetings of the Managing Committee

The Managing Committee met 4 times during the year and at these meetings decisions regarding the various activities of Margi were taken (Dates of meeting 30.3.89, 27.9.89 and 29.12.89).

Instruction Programme in Kathakali, Koodiyattom, Chakiyarkoothu and Nangiarkuthu

The Margi Kathakali Vidyalaya, which was started in 1974 for imparting rigorous training in all branches of Kathakali in the GURUKULA SAMPRADAYA, functioned with Padmashree Kalamandalam Krishnan Nair as the visiting Professor. The Professors are Inchakkatu Ramachandran Pillai (Veshom) Kalamandalam Haridas (Pattu) (Chenda) Kalanilayam Namboodiri Raman Kalamandalam (Maddalam) R.L.V.Somadas (Chutty) etc. Shri Margi Vijayakumar and Oyoor Ratheesan were the other teachers. There were 19 students in all undergoing training in the various disciplines of Kathakali viz. Veshom, Pattu, Chenda, Maddalam and Chutty. Shri R.L.V. Somadas functioned as manager for co-ordinating the functions of the departments as well as for arranging programmes. The Koodiyattom Vidyalaya, which was started in May 1980 for teaching Koodiyattom in the Gurukula System, functioned with Padmashree Ammannur Madhava Chakiyar as visiting Professor Kalamandalam Kochukuttan Chakiyar and Moozhikulam Unnikrishnan as Professors for Veshom and Mizhavu. There were 4 students undergoing training in Koodiyattom, Chakiyar Koothu, Nangiyar Koothu and Mizhavu.

The trainees in both the schools were progressing satisfactorily; those at the senior fellowship levels, in particular, have considerably improved their standards of performance; vastly benefitt-

ing from the intensive training which they receive from Shri Kalamandalam Krishnan nair etc. and the improved performance opportunities which they get in Margi.

Performances Staged at Margi

The performances staged at Margi are in reality, extensions of the training which the artistes receive at the Vidyalayas. The emphasis in the training and performances is on maintaining the highest traditional values so that these arts are nurtured and are presented to the discerning public in all their time honoured beauty and classicism. This approach is fast gaining ground and will be of great benefit in the larger prespective of the future of these arts, which constitute the unique and essential theatre of Kerala.

Other Performances

Promotion of Tourism: During the year, MARGI arranged 49 performances for outside agencies. A good number of these were for the benefit of overseas tourists from other parts of India, staged at the Asoka Beach Resort, Kovalam under the auspices of the Tourism Department of Kerala, which in recent years, is implementing several cultural programmes for acquainting tourists with the rich cultural heritage of our state. MARGI also participated in the Tourism Week Celebrations of the Government under the classical arts section (Kathakali, Koodiyattom and Koothu).

Project "Nalacharitham"

The project, consisting of a very detailed presentation of the popular Nalacharitha attakatha, by drawing extensively from ancient and rare literary sources on the subject, has been sanctioned by the Department of Cultural Affairs, Government of India. Work on the project is almost complete.

Ford Foundation Grant

The Ford Foundation has sanctioned a project for support of certain areas in Koodiyattom, linked with the Sanskrit theatre; the object being revival of acts which have long ceased to be performed and also for new performances texts; all in relation to 'Ascharyachoodamani' of Sakthibhadra. The project covers 3 years and work on the first year's programme is well advanced.

Accounts

A brief note on the Accounts for 1989 is appended.

Acknowledgements

The Managing Committee hereby conveys its deep sense of gratitude to the Government of Kerala (Department of Cultural Affairs, Tourism Department and Public Relations Department) Government of India, Department of Culture; Kendra Sangeet Nataka Academy; Kerala Sangeet Nataka Academy; Travancore Devoswom Board; Indian Council for Cultural Relations and the Ford Foundation for the valued assistance and co-operation extended to Margi in carrying out its programmes. The committee also wishes to thank all the members, for the active interest evinced by them in the propagation of classical art forms.

ACCOUNTS

The Audited Accounts for 1989 consisting of Income and Expenditure Account, Balance Sheet and other schedule are appended to this report.

The accounts for the year show an overall excess of Income over expenditure of Rs.1043/- A comparison with the previous years and a general appraisal is furnished below.

The deficit in the school account arise since the Government grant for running the Kathakali and Koodiyattom schools cover only the salaries and stipends (Mainly). It does not cover even essential items of other expenditure for running the schools, such as maintenance of building, rent, electricity charges, maintenance of costumes and equipments etc. Stipends are also limited by Government to a flat Rs.175/- P.M. for instructions at all levels, while we pay Rs.300/- Rs.250/- etc. for trainees at senior fellowship levels.

The deficit is also kept down to the barest minimum as may be seen from the fact that there are no administrative overheads (No Office staff, no sitting fee for members or expenses like TA, telephone charges etc; the requirements in this behalf being met by voluntarary effort on the part of the office bearers and committee members).

Low Salaries to Staff

The current rate of salary for the senior teachers of the Margi Schools is of the order of Rs.700/- permensum and for junior teachers Rs.400/- per mensum - perhaps the lowest salary level anywhere. It is indeed unfortunate that Government have not enhanced these very low salary to reasonable levels. Varying degrees of relief have been granted to all salaried sections - but the salaries of teachers of Margi remains unchanged, not withstanding the fact that there is specific plan provision for this object and the same has not been utilised for the just and proper object for which it was made.

The position has been brought to the notice of the Government several times and had also been explained in detail to a special committee which was set up by the Government to enquire into the requirements of various cultural organisations receiving grant from Government.

It is earnestly hoped that Government will remedy this long standing and fundamental grievance of the very low paid employees of margi.
